Located in the former corn crib of the farm, Roost offers eclectic gifts and décor with a touch of Bohemian chic.

A parking lot was removed in front of Roost to create a public courtyard at the core of the Sculpture Garden. The newly landscaped area features an open plaza in the center of which is a two-tiered masonry water fountain created by Fearington's own construction crew. Extensive plantings including boxwood, nandinas, kousa dogwood trees and four beautiful live oaks encircle the space. Outdoor tables and chairs under umbrellas offer a truly delightful spot to relax and enjoy a glass of wine or a cappuccino from [The Belted Goat](#), located just next door.
