



FEARRINGTON INTRODUCES ROOST, A BEER GARDEN

Pittsboro, NC, May 14, 2010 – In May, Fearington Village welcomed its newest addition: Roost, a beer garden. Set under large oak trees in the heart of the Village Center, Roost includes a charming cottage that once served as the corn crib of the Fearington farm and a surrounding courtyard where friends and family gather to enjoy craft beer and fellowship “al fresco”. The courtyard includes dozens of tables, chairs, umbrellas, locally made outdoor art exhibited as part of Fearington's Sculpture Garden and a graceful two-tiered water fountain that offers additional seating. Background music, either recorded and live, is a regular feature as well.

Theresa Chiettini, General Manager of Fearington Village said: “We’re really excited about Roost. Fearington residents have been asking for a casual place to meet for a drink, and it gives our Inn guests, shoppers and other visitors to the Village Center another entertainment option. We’re also pleased it’s been drawing folks who live just outside Fearington too. Between the beautiful setting and focus on local fare, it’s a one-of-a-kind amenity.”

Roost is proud to sell beers on tap by locally-owned Carolina Brewery, which has drawn international attention for its handcrafted beers. Among the award-winning signature beers Roost carries are: Flagship IPA (Gold Medal, Great American Beer Festival), Copperline Amber Ale (Gold Medal, World Beer Championships), and Sky Blue Golden Ale (Silver Medal, World Beer Championships).

Roost also offers a selection of wines by the glass, bottled ales and water, and light fare ranging from salted Virginia peanuts in the shell to bread to simple dishes prepared by the Fearington House Restaurant, including a cheese plate, charcuterie, and ploughman's platter.

Robert Poitras, owner of Carolina Brewery said: “The Fearington reputation for high quality is known around the world and we are honored they choose us as their local partners for craft beer. I think the Roost concept is unique to the area and provides customers with a wonderful relaxed outdoor setting and premium food and beverage. We are very pleased with the initial response from customers and look forward to a long partnership.”
