FEATURED WINES BY THE GLASS

Sparkling Wine

**Pommery, Brut Royal,
Reims, France**

M.V. 19.00 85.00

This dry yellow-gold sparkler is bursting with orchard fruit—Anjou pears, tart green apples, and yellow plums. On the palate, this lively champagne shows notes of toasty brioche, chalk, and a creamy body. It has a refreshing lemon and quince finish—definitely made for memorable toasts.

**Argyle, Brut,
Willamette Valley, Oregon, USA**

2007 14.00 65.00

A blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay this American Bubbly is a true classic. This wine displays notes of lemon juice, tarragon, baked scones, and yellow raspberries on the nose. On the palate it is dry, with fresh fruit and creamy flavors, and a persistent pearl.

**Contadi Castaldi, Rose, Brut,
Franciacorta, Lombardia, Italy**

M.V. 12.00 55.00

Notes of springtime emerge from this blush-hued sparkling wine – wild strawberries, rhubarb, citrus peel, and creamy Greek yoghurt are apparent on the nose and the palate. It is smooth, with refreshing bubbles, and a persistent finish.

White Wine

**Ramey Wine Cellars, Chardonnay,
Healdsburg, Sonoma Coast, California, USA**

2008 15.00 70.00

This wine is expressive on the nose with notes of caramelized pears, red delicious apples, and white peaches. On the palate, it offers even more flavors of musky oranges, savory *pain grille* topped with Normandy butter, and oak.

**Evening Land Vineyards, Bourgogne Blanc,
Burgundy, France**

2010 14.00 65.00

This Chardonnay offer notes of Meyer Lemon zest, sliced kumquats, yellow pears, and green apple skins. It has a crisp and tangy acidity, with a medium weight, and a long minerally finish.

**Reichsgraf von Kesselstatt, Riesling, Kabinett,
Piesporter Goldtröpfchen, Mosel, Germany**

2009 9.00 40.00

This floral wine has notes of apricots, golden peaches, yellow plums, ginger, lavender, and hibiscus. On the palate, it has a touch of residual sugar; is medium-minus in body, with medium plus vibrant acidity and a long slate mineral finish.

**Leth, Roter Veltliner, Hofweingarten,
Wagram, Austria**

2009 8.00 35.00

Roter Veltliner is the parent of the who's who of Austrian grapes, producing elegant wines with notes of pear, honey, white pepper, and cumin. It is medium-plus in body with an oily texture, but with lively acidity that balances it out.

**Chehalem Vineyards, Pinot Gris,
Willamette Valley, Oregon, USA**

2009 10.00 45.00

This wine shows notes of red apple skins, yellow pears, peanut shells, and white flowers on the nose. On the palate, it has a stony minerality, with lemon zest flavors. It has medium plus body, medium acidity, and a refreshing finish.

**Gerard Fiou, Sancerre,
Loire Valley, France**

2010 12.00 55.00

This wine displays notes of tangerine skins, grapefruits, white peaches, red bell peppers, smoke, and marjoram on the nose. On the palate, it has an herbaceous quality, coupled with a medium plus acidity, medium body and a citrus finish.

**Királyudvar, Furmint, Tokaji, Sec,
Percze, Hungary**

2009 10.00 45.00

This dry wine is leesy on the nose, with caramelized orchard fruits, flamed Valencia orange skins, honey, and hazelnuts. The full-bodied texture of the wine is balanced by its lively acidity on the palate and ends with a long, expressive finish.

**Bodega Bouza, Albariño,
Montevideo, Uruguay**

2010 9.00 40.00

On the nose, it displays pungent aromas of ripe apricots and orange oil, with hints of white floral notes. On the palate, it has medium plus acid, medium plus body and a long citrus finish.

**Clos Roche Blanche, Pineau d'Aunis, Rose,
Touraine, Loire Valley, France**

2010 10.00 45.00

This pink-hued wine has prominent notes of flowers and spices, with white pepper, coriander and geraniums on the forefront. On the palate, flavors of strawberries, rhubarbs, and under-ripe raspberries are apparent.

Red Wine

**Hochar Pere et Fils, Château Musar,
Bekaa Valley, Lebanon**

2004 14.00 65.00

From the philosopher of wine himself, Serge Hochar, comes this ethereal blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Carignan, Cinsault, and Grenache. It is in its league on its own, incomparable to any wine. It has notes of red plum skins, dried cherry, raspberries, with secondary notes of leather, white pepper, and violets. The wine is warm on the palate, with inviting ripeness, friendly acidity, and a long, complex finish.

**Trefethen Family Vineyards, Merlot,
Oak Knoll of Napa Valley, Napa Valley, California, USA**

2008 11.00 50.00

On the nose, the wine displays stewed raspberries, black cherries, tomato leaves, and spicy oak notes. On the palate, it has dried sage leaves, cedar, and leather. It is medium plus in body, with medium plus tannins, balanced acidity, and a black pepper finish.

**Domaine Terlato-Chapoutier, Syrah-Viognier,
Victoria, Australia**

2009 12.00 55.00

A collaboration between the Rhone Valley's Michel Chapoutier and the Terlato Family from Napa Valley, the wine is harmonious blend of old and new world flavors. It has spicy red fruit aromas of dark raspberries, red currants, and cherries. It has a vibrant acidity and florality from the addition of Viognier in the blend.

**Fiddlehead Cellars, Fiddlestix, Seven-Twenty-Eight, Pinot Noir,
Sta. Rita Hills, Santa Barbara County, California, USA**

2008 15.00 70.00

This silky and elegant Pinot Noir displays notes of stewed black cherries, ripe raspberries, and red plums. Also apparent on the nose are aromas of crushed graham crackers, cola, and an organic mineral component. This medium bodied wine has medium plus acidity, and a long finish.

**Durigutti, Malbec,
Mendoza, Argentina**

2009 9.00 40.00

Intensely colored and full of ripe black fruit flavors, this jammy wine displays notes of dark plums, macerated wild strawberries, black cherry liqueur, mocha, licorice, and leather. On the palate, it has a classic Malbec texture, with a racy acidity, and a long finish.

**Pascal Granger, Cuvée Spéciale, Grand Reserve, Gamay,
Juliéna, Beaujolais, France**

2003 12.00 55.00

On the nose, this wine displays ripe blackberries, dried wild cherries, and strawberries. Notes of rose petals and red currants are also apparent alongside a distinct earthy complexity. On the palate, it is medium plus in body, with medium plus acidity, earthy tannins, and a long finish.

**Avignonesi, Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, Sangiovese,
Tuscany, Italy**

2008 15.00 70.00

Bright fruits notes highlight this old world gem of a wine, with red currants, wild cherry liqueur, blackberries, and tomato leaves on the nose. Delicate floral and mineral notes are also present. It has well integrated oak, an elegant mouth feel and a balanced acidity.

CHAMPAGNE

In many ways, Champagne is the best wine in the world. It can be refreshing, lively, celebratory, serious, complex, in your face, or subtle all in a few sniffs and sips. It can pair with more foods than almost any other wine, and it is extremely difficult to make, that is, in comparison to a large section of other wines. However, it seems that so many forget about Champagne and all sparkling wine for that matter, some only drink it to celebrate, and some just think it is not "serious" enough to be considered in the same breath as the Burgundies or Bordeaux of the world. Both the former and the latter are missing a whole lot of enjoyment, and in turn, missing one of the most exciting regions in France. Champagne is no longer just about the image or the brand; it is revolutionizing to be about the family, the grower, and the *terroir*. This is not to say that the larger Champagne houses make inferior wine, they in fact, make great bubbly; it is just that they represent a different idea—a different perspective. What everyone loves about Burgundy or the Rhône Valley, is that the wines show a sense of place—they are where they are from, and that is why wine lovers go crazy about them.

With the plethora of owner-producers coming into the American market, we are able to experience the same from Champagne. What these producers do is make "localized" Champagne, they are using grapes from their village, and more often these days, even single vineyard sites. Some like Bertrand Gautherot of Vouette & Sorbée go as far as naming his winery after his two single vineyards, which he farms biodynamically. Though we love all great Champagne, we suggest that if you have not tried an owner-producer Champagne that you ask about our selection of amazing wines. All of the grower-owned wines have an RM mark on them, representing the legal designation of *Récoltant-Manipulant*, and all of the other producers will have NM mark, which stands for *Négociant-Manipulant*. The NM designation stands for producers who can purchase grapes and *vins clairs* from growers, cooperatives and other houses. This does not mean that they all do not grow their own grapes, some of the NMs grow their own grapes for almost 2/3rd of their production, while others purchase all, so it is really a matter of House tradition. Either way, we hope you love these wines as much as we do, and if you have any questions about any of the producers, please do not hesitate.

Burlotto, Verduno, Piemonte – In many ways, Giovanni Battista Burlotto was the first winemaker to put Barolo on the map of the international wine world. He was a winemaker from 1850 to 1927 and in that time transitioned what Barolo meant to the world. He was the first to bottle his Barolos, predating even Giacomo Conterno's Monfortino, putting the town of Verduno on par with the famous Serralunga and La Morra. After his death, the town of Verduno lost its luster and reputation for being one of the best areas for Nebbiolo. Now there is a rebirth with Giovanni's great-great-grandson Fabio Alessandria taking over as winemaker and a renewed focus on bringing back the wines of Verduno. The wines are classic Barolo where the grapes are foot-trodden, then go on to a 60-day maceration, and into large *Botte* (Oak Casks) where they rest. The Estate is made up of 30 acres, 24 of which lie in Verduno, home to the famous *Monvigliero* cru. The Burlottos are also credited, in particular, Giovanni's son Francesco, for keeping alive the *Pelaverga Piccolo* grape variety, which he felt was most at home in the *terroir* of Verduno. These wines are very special; they speak to the history of a great winemaker, Giovanni, his legacy, and the history of a small town dedicated to the vine.

Castello di Verduno, Verduno, Piemonte – The Castle itself was originally built in 1500 in the town of Verduno. It fell into the jurisdiction of the House of Savoy in 1631 and eventually into the royal family's ownership by 1831. It is at this time that winemaking history was made. King Carlo Alberto hired the then famous oenologist General Carlo Staglieno, who went on to make some of the first vinified versions of Nebbiolo, the blueprint for modern Barolo. Coincidentally, the Burlotto family (remember them?), purchased the property in 1909. The success of the winery today can be attributed to Giovanni's grandson, none other than *Commandatore* Giovanni Battista Burlotto, who on returning from Eritrea, took the *Castello*, which had been largely ignored, remodeled it, turned part of it into an inn and restaurant, and put emphasis back on the wine. The winery is now run by Gabriella Burlotto and Franco Bianco (who hails from Barbaresco, and has contributed the land that goes into the Castello di Verduno Barbarescos), working together in keeping the traditional methods of the house. Here, the wines go through a long maceration, with fermentation in open tanks, and aging in large *botte*. These wines, from the Barbaresco Normale, to the Barbaresco *Rabaja*, and Barolo *Massara*, can predispose oneself to an out-of-body experience. They have rich, alluring aromatics, where floral meets earth, and picking plums in the summer melding with freshly shaved white truffles in the fall. The palate has all the drama of a soap opera, with high acidity and high tannin, but mellowed with rich dark fruit, and a finish that will not soon be forgotten.

Chateau Musar was founded by Gaston Hochar in 1931, with a vision to make exceptional wines from the Bekaa Valley. His son Serge Hochar, who graduated from the University of Bordeaux with a degree in Oenology in 1959, brought the winery into the international spotlight. The blend for the red wines is generally Cabernet Sauvignon, Cinsault, and Carignan. The wines of Chateau Musar are perhaps some of the most age-worthy in the world, with alluring aromatics and beautiful structure on the palate. The Bekaa Valley is a perfect spot for viticulture, with 300 days a year of sunshine, a Mediterranean climate, and gravelly topsoil with a limestone base (perfect soil for Cabernet Sauvignon). These are wines not to be missed, and once tasted will always be remembered.
