FEARRINGTON VILLAGE WALKING PATH NETWORK EXPANDED

Pittsboro, NC, August 12, 2009 – Farrington Village announces the completion of a significant expansion of its gravel walking path network. The addition gives residents and guests a shaded, quiet route as they walk to the shops and restaurants of the Village Center, stroll the beautiful 16-acre Camden Park, collect mail at the Millcroft postal kiosk, visit neighbors and take exercise.

The new path connects to the existing walking path network in Camden Park, creating a continuous pedestrian route from the Village Center to Farrington's southern neighborhoods, including our newest neighborhoods, Millcroft Close and The Knolls.

The new, nearly mile-long path which was built by our own construction crews, roughly flanks both East Camden and Millcroft roads, but also meanders through adjacent hardwood forests and over streams and offers views of meadows containing our prize-winning Belted Galloway cows.

The southern path adds to an existing system of walking paths that head north and east from the Village Center to the Swim & Croquet Club and into adjacent neighborhoods.
