The most educated place in N.C. is in the Triangle

The tiny, U.S. Census-designated place of Fearington Village near Pittsboro, population 2,600, is the most educated "town" in North Carolina, according to data collected from the American Community Survey.

Business Insider ranked U.S. towns with a population of at least 1,000 and ranked them based on highest percentage of adults over 25 who have at least a bachelor's degree. The result is [this map](#) of all 50 states and their most educated towns.

In Fearington Village, 76 percent of residents over 25 have bachelor's degrees.
